Die Expeditionsleitung wird ihr Möglichstes tun, damit der deutschsprachige Guide auf jedem Ausflug den deutschsprachigen Gästen bestmöglichst zur Verfügung steht, entweder im Zodiac oder auf den Landgängen.

BRIEFINGS

Alle vorgeschriebenen Briefings, wie zum Beispiel das IAATO, Bordsicherheits- und Zodiac Briefing, werden auf Deutsch angeboten (entweder an einem separaten Ort oder es wird simultanübersetzt über ein Audiosystem).

EINFÜHRUNG

Jeder deutschsprachige Passagier findet bei Ankunft in der Kabine ein Begrüßungs- und Informationsschreiben vor, welches den deutschsprachigen Expeditions-Guide vorstellt. Spätestens beim 'Willkommen an Bord' Treffen aller Passagiere, wird sich Ihr deutschsprachiger Guide bei Ihnen vorstellen und steht anschließend sofort für die Beantwortung etwaiger Fragen zur Verfügung.

RECAPS

Die regulären Tageszusammenfassungen (Recaps) werden entweder simultan (per Audiosystem) vom Englischen ins Deutsche übersetzt, oder es wird eine verkürzte Tageszusammenfassung in Deutsch angeboten. Oder aber, der deutschsprachige Guide fasst die wichtigsten Informationen der englischen Präsentation im Anschluss informell für die deutschsprachigen Gäste zusammen und steht für Fragen zur Verfügung.

Lauritz Schönenfeld

GEOLOGE, GLAZIOLOGE & DEUTSCHSPRACHIGER EXPEDITIONSGUIDE

Als professioneller Guide und Geologe/Glaziologe arbeitet Lauritz seit 2013 in den Polarregionen. Seine Leidenschaft für kalte Orte entwickelte sich 2010-11 während eines Schüleraustauschjahres in Nuuk, Grönland. Fasziniert nicht nur von endlosen Gletschern, dem vielen Schnee, frostigen Temperaturen und weitläufigen Landschaften, sondern auch von der Herzlichkeit der grönlandischen Menschen, wagt er sich seitdem wieder in diese Regionen, um dort zu leben und zu arbeiten. Sein Geologiestudium hat ihn an einige der entlegensten Orte auf diesem Globus gebracht, wie z.B. Spitzbergen, wo er am Universitätszentrum in Longyearbyen arktische Geologie studierte. Lauritz spricht außerdem mehrere Sprachen fließend, wie Englisch, Deutsch und Dänisch, hat aber auch umfangreiche Kenntnisse in Grönlandisch, Norwegisch, Latein und Altgriechisch. Sein Rat für „Polar-Neulinge“ ist, die Kamera öfter aus der Hand zu legen und die atemberaubende Landschaft zu genießen, die oft plötzlichen Veränderungen und verblassenden Momenten unterliegt. Wenn er nicht gerade die Polarregionen erkundet, kann man Lauritz beim Wandern oder Fliegen in den Schweizer Alpen, seiner neuen Heimat, antreffen. Er liebt es, Polargäste zu beobachten, die sich über den ersten Blick auf einen entfernten Eisberg in der untergehenden Sonne freuen.



Dany Zbinden

MEERESBIOLOGE & DEUTSCHSPRACHIGER EXPEDITIONSGUIDE

Aufgewachsen in der Nähe von Segelbooten und Wasser, entwickelte Dany schon früh eine tiefe Faszination für die aquatische Umwelt und die Tierwelt. Als Student verbrachte er seine Sommer beim Segeln auf der Ostsee und der Nordsee und beim Tauchen im Atlantik und Mittelmeer. Als Schweiz-Kanadier und Meeresbiologe mit einem Master-Abschluss der Universität Zürich beschäftigt er sich seit 1993 mit der Forschung, der Öffentlichkeitsarbeit und dem Schutz von Meeressäugern. Dany ist ein zertifizierter Walstrandungs-Helfer bei der „Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary“ und hat die Lizenz, mit einer Armbrust Biopsien an Walen durchzuführen. Man kann sagen, dass die Meeresswelt für dieses Landei aus der ländlichen Schweiz ein zweites Zuhause geworden ist. Nach einem Forschungsprojekt über die Bioakustik von nordatlantischen Zwergwalen im subarktischen Sankt-Lorenz-Golf, Kanada, gründete Dany 2001 eine gemeinnützige Organisation namens „Mériscopé Marine Research Station“. Mériscopé ermöglichte zahlreiche Forschungsprojekte über Meeressäuger, die von der Bioakustik der Tiere über Fütterungsstrategien bis hin zu den biologischen Auswirkungen von langlebigen Schadstoffen reichen. Die Forschungsarbeiten umfassten eine breite Palette von Arten, darunter Zahnwale wie Schwinswale und Belugas, sowie Bartenwale wie Zwergwale und Blauwale. Als Geschäftsführer von Mériscopé kam Dany bei einem einwöchigen Workshop für Polarpädagogen im Jahr 2012 zum ersten Mal mit der Polarforschung in Berührung und kam 2017 zu Quark Expeditions. Dany liebt es unvergessbare Tierbegegnungen für polare Gäste zu schaffen, sei es mit einem Pinguin, einer Robbe, einem Wal oder sogar einem Manteltier!

Die großzügige Aussichtsplattform im Freien ist ideal um täglich neue Entdeckungen zu machen. Die Observation-Lounge mit gewölbter Decke erlaubt einen herrlichen Blick nach oben. In der Bibliothek finden Sie ein ruhiges Plätzchen zum Entspannen und in der Explorer Lounge können Sie einen Drink bei netter Unterhaltung genießen. Präsentationen werden in einem eigenen Vortragssaal abgehalten. 

Ocean Explorer

UNSERE FLOTTE

Die *Ocean Explorer*, das neueste Mitglied unserer Flotte, ist modern, elegant und speziell für Polarexpeditionen gebaut. Das Schiff bietet Platz für 138 Passagiere und ist mit der neuesten Technologie für Expeditionen auf See ausgestattet. Eines der wichtigsten Merkmale des Schiffs ist der ULSTEIN X-BOW®, eine Innovation in der Schiffstechnik, die dank des nach hinten geneigten Bugs eine komfortablere und ruhigere Fahrt ermöglicht. Am Bug befindet sich auch die zweistöckige und helle Bibliothek, die dem Expeditionsschiff eine willkommene Leichtigkeit verleiht. Die geräumigen Kabinen sind im modernen, maßgeschneiderten skandinavischen Design gestaltet und haben fast alle einen Balkon. Zur Entspannung für die Gäste stehen ein geräumiger Fitnessraum, eine Sauna mit großen Fenstern und zwei Außenwhirlpools bereit. Die *Ocean Explorer* hat große äußere Aussichtsbereiche und Außendecks auf verschiedenen Höhen, ideal für Panoramafotos und Tierbeobachtung. Das Schiff ist mit 15 Zodiac-Schlauchbooten ausgestattet, mit denen die Gäste schnell und sicher Ausflüge abseits des Schiffs machen können. Neben den gut ausgestatteten und geräumigen Gemeinschaftsbereichen hat die *Ocean Explorer* auch einen branchenführenden Mix aus Nachhaltigkeitsmaßnahmen, einschließlich kraftstoffeffizienter Rolls-Royce-Motoren.

(an ausgewählten Terminen)

Übernachten Sie in der Antarktis unter freiem Himmel! Stellen Sie sich vor, wie die endlose Polardämmerung – bei gutem Wetter – die umliegende Gletscherlandschaft in prächtige Farben taucht. Der Alltag wird zu einer fernen Erinnerung, wenn Sie beim Einschlafen der antarktischen Natursymphonie lauschen. Sie bekommen an Bord ein vollständiges Briefing und werden somit optimal auf Ihre unvergessliche Nacht unter dem antarktischen Sommerhimmel vorbereitet. Nach dem Abendessen ziehen Sie sich warm an für die Zodiac-Fahrt zur Übernachtung an Land. Mit Ihrem Biwaksack, einer Isomatte und Schlafsack sind Sie gut für die Nacht im Schnee gerüstet. Wir empfehlen aufgrund einer limitierten Teilnehmerzahl, diesen Ausflug im Voraus zu buchen.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Lust auf ein aktives Abenteuer? Zusammen mit lokalen Partnern haben wir Mountainbike-Routen durch die atemberaubende Landschaft Südgrönlands ausgewählt. Die beiden 2-motorigen Helikopter der *Ultramarine* bringen Sie zum Startpunkt und holen Sie am Ziel wieder ab. Die HeliMountainbike Touren dauern 4 bis 6 Stunden, davon ca. 2 bis 3 Stunden auf dem Rad. Die Teilnehmer müssen fit sein und über gute Kondition verfügen. Die Strecke führt größtenteils über Schotterstraßen mit einigen Offroad Passagen. Die Fahrer sollten daher in der Lage sein kleine Hindernisse (wie Wurzeln oder Felsen) zu bewältigen und ihre Gänge der Strecke entsprechend anzupassen.



STAND-UP PADDLEBOARDING

(nur auf *World Explorer* und *Ultramarine*)

Die Kombination von Surfen mit Kajakfahren, Stehpaddeln und Paddeln ermöglicht Ihnen eine sehr persönliche und einzigartige Perspektive auf die Antarktis. An ruhigen Seetagen gleiten Sie durch stille Buchten und erleben die Tierwelt wassernah (einmalige Aktivität). Zu Ihrer Sicherheit werden Sie von einem Zodiac während des Ausfluges begleitet. Wir empfehlen aufgrund einer limitierten Teilnehmerzahl, diesen Ausflug im Voraus zu buchen.



SEA KAYAKING

Stellen Sie sich vor, in einer von Eisbergen und Gletschern umgebenen Bucht, über stilles Wasser zu gleiten. Für erfahrene Kanuten bietet unser Sea Kayaking Programm die Möglichkeit, das Polarmeer und die Eislandschaft auf intime Weise zu erkunden. Kayak-Touren werden wetterabhängig mehrmals während der Reise, als Alternative zu Landgängen und Zodiac-Fahrten angeboten. Vorkenntnisse sind Teilnahmevoraussetzung. Sie müssen in der Lage sein, ohne Hilfe aus Ihrem Kajak auszusteigen (Wet Exit). Für den interessierten Anfänger bietet unser Paddling Excursion Programm eine wunderbare Alternative.



PADDLING EXCURSION

Für interessierte Kajakliebhaber mit wenig oder keiner Erfahrung, bieten wir an ruhigen Seetagen Touren in unseren offenen Paddelbooten an (einmalige Aktivität). Unsere erfahrenen Kajak-Guides begleiten Sie auf dieser Ausfahrt und helfen Ihnen, Ihre Zeit im Polarmeer zu einem unvergesslichen Erlebnis zu machen. 


